If you can't print or iPad can't find the printer, try some troubleshooting steps that solve the most common problems. These troubleshooting tips work with iPadOS 14, iPadOS 13, and all currently supported versions of iOS. The most common problem occurs when the iPad fails to find or recognize the printer. The main cause of this problem is that the iPad and the printer do not communicate correctly between them. Some printers, especially AirPrint printers disable automatic ignition, so check the printer status first. Make sure you are connected to the correctNetwork. AirPrint works on Wi-Fi, so if you are connected to the Internet using 4G, you can't print on the network printer. You need to connect via Wi-Fi network, but some routers broadcast on a 2.4 GHz network and a 5 GHz network. Large houses can have a Wi-Fi extender that broadcasts on a different network. Ensure both the iPad and the printer again.
